COURSE OUTLINE

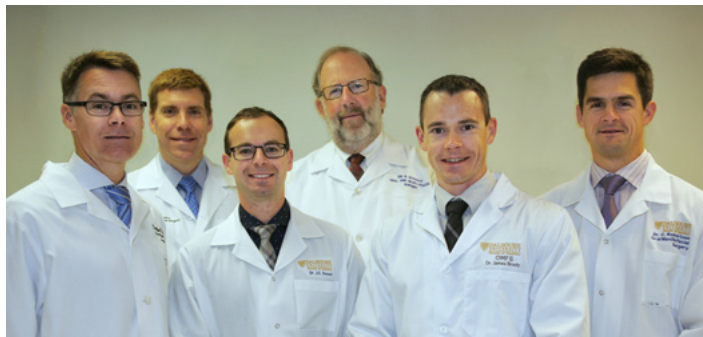
This course will cover updates within the field of oral and maxillofacial surgery.
